PRACTICE REGISTRATION

Practices that wish to be recognised as a SAIA Practice shall apply annually to the Institute and shall:

- In accordance with the SAIA Constitution clause 6.5.3 once accepted into the Institute, a member becomes eligible to register as a SAIA Practice. A minimum of one principal at a practice shall be an Architect Member as set out in clause 6.1.1.1

of the SAIA Constitution and should be in good standing at the time of the application.

- All architectural principals of such practice shall be members of the Institute in any of the membership classes as set out in clause 6.1 of the SAIA Constitution. And should be in good standing at the time of the application. A minimum of 51% of all staff employed at the practice, who are eligible to be a voting member according to clause 6.1.1 of the SAIA Constitution, shall be Institute members and should be in good standing at the time of the application.

- The practice requesting acknowledgment as a SAIA Practice shall apply annually. An application form shall be complete, signed and return to the Institute and the SAIA regions. Declarations illustrating compliance of 8.1.1, 8.1.2, and 8.1.3 shall be included in the application form. Should the practice comply with all the requirements above, the Institute shall issue a certificate of good standing, valid for the financial year, in recognition of the SAIA Practice.

- SAIA Registered Practices are Eligible for the Regional and National Awards program:

- Eligibility to enter the Awards Program hosted regionally every second year (available to SAIA Registered Practices).

- Eligibility to enter the National Awards Program hosted Nationally in the following year, for any projects that won a Regional Award.

- Membership Certificate issued yearly, which can be displayed at your office, as well as being able to use membership information in email signatures etc. for the period of membership.
